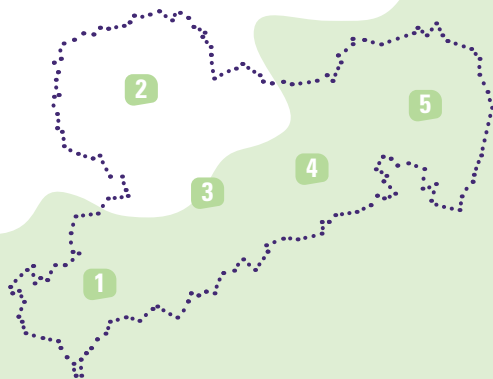

The FdaG is an excellent opportunity for contributing to public welfare. And this is completely independent of any specific professional qualification and education!

The FdaG is especially fit for people who are looking for a meaningful challenge and want to pass on their life experience, but also for people who are looking for inspiration for their future or have some time to fill between jobs. Of course you can acquire new skills and contribute your own experiences and interests. The idea is to take time for other people or simply do people something good.

An expense allowance is granted when working for the FdaG. FdaG volunteers are deployed in public welfare institutions.

X GENERAL CONDITIONS

Anyone aged 18
and older can do an
FdaG. Seniors are
welcome.

The deployment
times can vary
between 8 and 20
hours per week.

An FdaG period
lasts between 6 and
24 months.

An expense allo-
wance is granted
monthly and
depends on the
weekly working
times.

There is insurance
coverage for liability
and accidents, but
no social security.

Our various deploy-
ment areas cover
social, cultural, and
ecological tasks.

There are regular
meetings for excu-
sions, education,
or exchange of
experiences.
